Description of Day 1:

The first day of the meeting was officially opened by Anastasia-Sotiria Toufa from the Municipality of Katerini. She presented the official agenda for the meeting and highlighted each of the activities that were to be carried out and the timeline that was to be followed.

The meeting continued with interactive ice-breaking activities presented by Nikoleta Karga, aimed at facilitating introductions and encouraging attendees to connect with one another. Participants were asked to randomly select a note with another participant's name and then share an interesting story about that person's name, a cultural tradition, or anything else they felt inclined to share. This was followed by an activity where everyone had to make three statements, two of which were true and one was a lie, and the rest of the participants had to guess which statement was false. The next and last activity involved everyone picking a number between 1 and 20, then answering the corresponding question. After completing the ice-break activities, attendees had the opportunity to continue socializing during a coffee break.















Maria Terzidou, the deputy mayor of tourism, then took the floor and presented Katerini as a tourist destination that caters to everyone, with activities available all year round. She highlighted the sea tracks in the area, which have been developed by the municipality with the full support of volunteers. These tracks are designed to allow for independent access for people with disabilities and mobility difficulties, making swimming an inclusive activity for everyone. She also talked about the local products, agriculture, wine, visitable wineries, small villages, and settlements that make Katerini a destination for all seasons.

Sehida Pala from ENSIE then held a workshop with the participants, where she covered the topic of social economy. Participants were divided into groups and asked questions related to the theme, with each group then presenting their answers. This sparked a lively discussion and gave the participants an opportunity to voice their opinions and concerns.















After lunch, the meeting reconvened at the Municipal Conference Center "Ekavi," where Maria Asteriou from People Behind, a non-governmental organization (NGO), presented their activities aimed at promoting the inclusion of older people. They offer workshops and e-learning courses for digital inclusion, participate in EU projects for domestic violence prevention, and more.

At the end of the day, the municipality presented its European programs aimed at promoting citizens' green and digital inclusion. These programs focus on creating sustainable and technology-driven opportunities for all. The head of the Development Planning and Organization Department, Aikaterini Poda, highlighted the results of the BIOWASTE project for the processing of biowaste, and the scientific advisor, Evgenia Telmetidou, presented the ETAPAS project for providing reliable services to the public through disruptive technologies.

Description of Day 2:

On the second day of the meeting, the participants took part in a study visit to several sites, which included a visit to the Mastodon Exhibit in Neokesareia, a Cultural Association that aims to enhance the local economy by combining paleontological findings with tourism and natural beauty. The group also visited the Asterias Swimming Center, a place that focuses on social inclusion for children including those with disabilities and older people. They provide lessons in STEM subjects through the medium of water and offer summer camps, activities in nature, and activities for autonomy.







The next stop was at the Karasimos Winery, a visitable winery that talked about partnerships and collaborations between local businesses to enhance the local economy. The winery participates in culinary festivals that are open to all without discrimination. The final visit was to the 3 Hills Boutique, which provides horse riding lessons to children with disabilities and Roma, and operates a greenhouse that produces natural products using pure materials. The day concluded with lunch at 3 Hills Boutique.

Description of Day 3:

On the third and final day, a study visit in Merimna was held, a top-rated school for children with disabilities that offers assisted living facilities to a few children. The school staff gave a tour of the facilities and demonstrated their approach to promoting the inclusion and independence of children with disabilities in daily life activities.

Next, the meeting continued in the Municipality of Katerini, where Katerina Samali, spoke about the municipality's initiatives to empower and engage the Roma community in various activities within the wider community.

A Women's Cooperative "Muses Pierion," which was established by unemployed women to produce handmade local products such as marmalade, pasta, and trachanas presented their work. The cooperative operates primarily through volunteer efforts and partnerships with local businesses.

Anastasia-Sotiria Toufa presented Novoville, a citizen engagement platform that bridges the gap between citizens and their local authorities. The delivery of public services is made more efficient, participatory, transparent and inclusive, increasing the digital inclusion of citizens. The European project Life was presented, where the goal of the project is the adaptation to climate change through renovation of public areas for making them accessible to the public. After lunch, each participant shared details about their organizations and the initiatives they undertake to enhance social and economic development in their communities. The participants displayed a keen eagerness to share successful initiatives implemented within their organizations, and an openness to showcase their efforts.

The meeting concluded with a presentation and roundtable discussion led by Sehida Pala about the implementation of the EU action plan at the local level. The participants worked in groups, exploring and recording potential tools and suggestions for local implementation.
