EDUCATION

- 1) Research analyzing how subjective interpretations and constructions of social reality can hide implicit prejudices that leads to discrimination and violence.
- 2) Transnational workshop to present the research results and draft the guidelines for the organization of local workshops aiming at dismantle these prejudices.
- 3) Local workshops to dismantle prejudices and replace hateful narratives with alternative narratives.
- **4) The "CAN Campaign"** allowing social/youth workers and front line actors to be involved in the fight against intolerance, racism and xenophobia.







- **5) Transnational training course for social/youth workers** provide tools and methods to counter radicalism and technical competences to build alternative narratives.
- 6) The "CAN LABs" (local level) skilled participants share with local communities what they have learnt during the training (public laboratories)
- 7) "EUCAN toolkit" collecting practical tools to improve citizens' knowledge and understanding of the EU, to support the integration process of immigrants and refugees EUCAN manual, the guidebook and CAN educational videos.
- 8) Final conference projection of CAN Educational Videos during the Film Festival, presentation of the EUCAN toolkit, launch of EUCAN Network



- 4) World Refugee Day where participants will be involved in screenings of thematic films and will take part to the #WithRefugees petition of UNHCR Spain.









1. RESEARCH PHASE

Reveal the perception and construction of "self/WE" as opposed to "others/THEY".

1.1. Campaign Phase

Fostering partnerships and supporting actors in their work to uphold and promote values of human rights and democratic citizenship







2.KICK-OFF MEETING

Identify the communities to involve in the project, to collect their data, to design and approve the 2 years timetable and to approve the work methodology.

Encourage local authorities to provide long-term investment in quality education, both formal and non-formal; to inspire more young people to participate to the youth sector activities in order to fight radicalization; to build a joint strategy for all stakeholders. (International Conference)

Hosts large group dialogue with a simple, effective, and flexible format. (World Café EUCAN)

Discover how works the Center of Refugees in Portugal (Study Visit)







3. TRANSNATIONAL WORKSHOP

Results of a research aiming at observing intergroup attitudes towards immigrant outgroups and the perception and construction of "self" and "they" by immigrants themselves.

Involving locals and non-EU foreign national currently living or staying in EU.

An useful action plan with monitoring tool included in order to implement the workshops "From knowledge to empathy, from empathy to integration".

Increase consciousness and perception of participants and public to the millions of refugees and internally displaced persons worldwide who have been forced to flee their homes due to war, conflict and persecution. (Celebration of World refugees day)

4. LOCAL WORKSHOPS

Dismantle and replace hateful narratives thus promoting democratic, intercultural engagement and civic participation of both citizens and non-EU foreign nationals.

Support communities to develop genuine/credible messages to counter radicalization, taking into consideration the local context and culture.

Building and spreading locally tailored counter-narratives thus promoting alternative role models.







5. TRANSNATIONAL SEMINAR

Improve counter extremism and radicalism NGO tools

Develop capacity to create a learning environment where the social and youth workers is flexible, confident, engaging the young into the space for dialogue.

Improve confidence and ability of social and youth workers to act in such a way that 'connects' with young people by allowing honest, trusting, and through appropriate use of humour and role-modelling of expected behaviours.







5.1 Workshop - Training session - Laboratories - Reflection / Mid term self assessment

Get and develop skills and know-how of participants to support young people to be able to cope with a range of different life pressures and challenges

Improve method that help young people become skilled at working collaboratively with others

Improve method that develop young people into critical thinkers who are able to appreciate a range of different perspectives in coming to their own judgments

To develop flexibility and creativity in counter-narrative design

Develop technical skills and knowledge about the right type of counter narratives in a given cultural context

Develop abilities to create dialogue within the communities on violent extremism to generate counter-narrative content.







5.2 Building labs

Gain skills for video preparation, script writing, recording, editing, finalizing and subtitling.

Gain the know-how to create an easy-language manual paper and digital version for a more easy exploitation of its contents.







6. COUNTER AND ALTERNATIVE NARRATIVES LABS

Develop and disseminate locally tailored counter-narratives

Promote alternative role models

Support communities to develop credible messages to counter radicalization, taking into consideration the local context and culture as well as challenges and feelings faced by their members

Introduce recommendations for civil society to counter radicalization

Develop an understanding of different attitudes towards violent extremism

Prepare a toolkit that will support non-EU foreign nationals, immigrants and refugees to understand cultural differences, EU aims and values to facilitate their integration process.







9.2 Study Visit to KHORA Foundation

Participants can study what are the necessary skills for establishing successful and sustainable projects that help thousands of refugees living far away from their home countries.

9.3 Study visit to Ritsona Refugee Camp

Study the good example of cooperation between a non-profit social enterprise, a non-profit organization actively supporting Greek civil society and a nonprofit organization that provides humanitarian aid through the coordination of skilled volunteers and translators.







10. INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE

Develop citizens' understanding of the Union policy making process and how UE helps civil society to become force for political reform and defence of human rights.
